“Snow Buddies” (Rated: G) will be shown. NO registration.

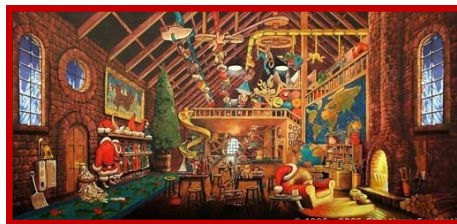
