
Now has come the time to apply the knowledge we have acquired and to strive for a place in society. The goals we have set for ourselves will begin to be realized and ultimately to be achieved.

Congratulations at this commencement time and best wishes in your future endeavors.



Our first formal dance will be forever remembered in our hearts as a truly momentous occasion.




