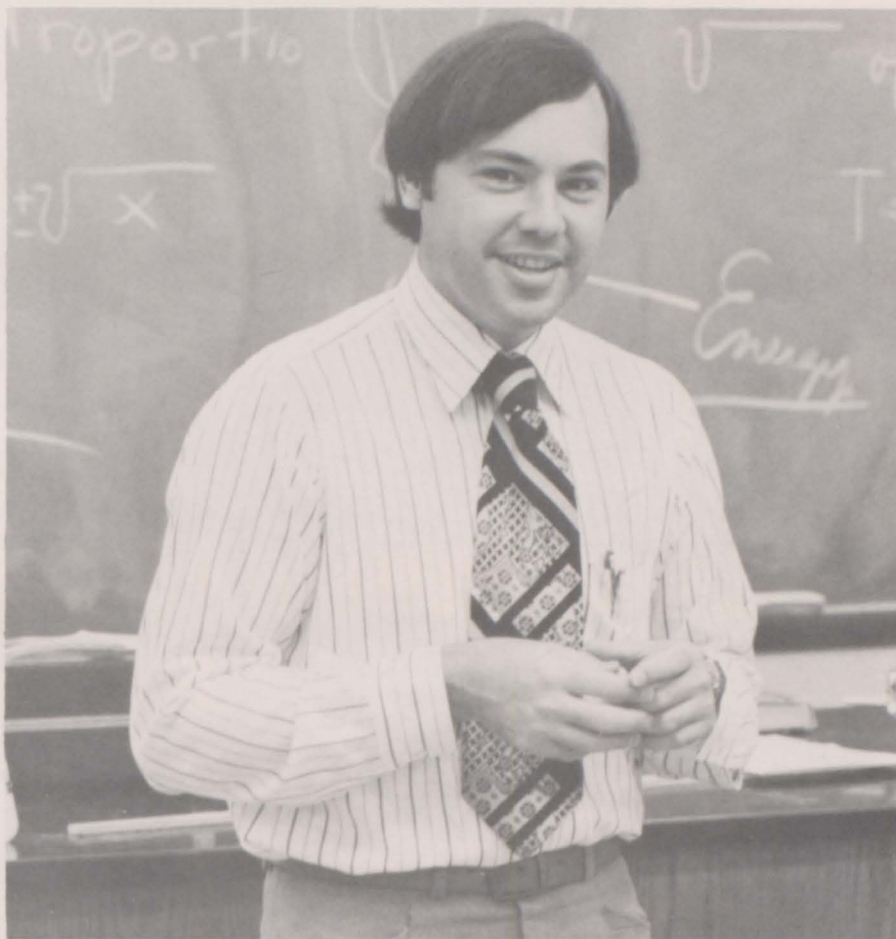
KNOTTY OAK DEDICATION
