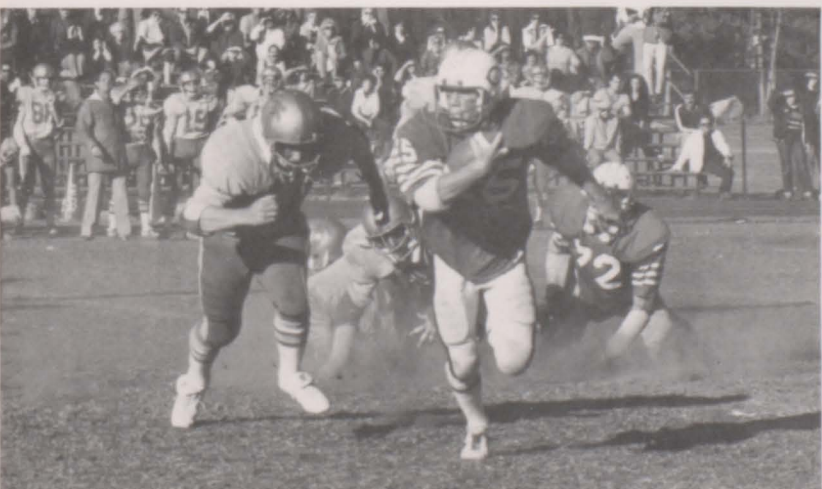
Football

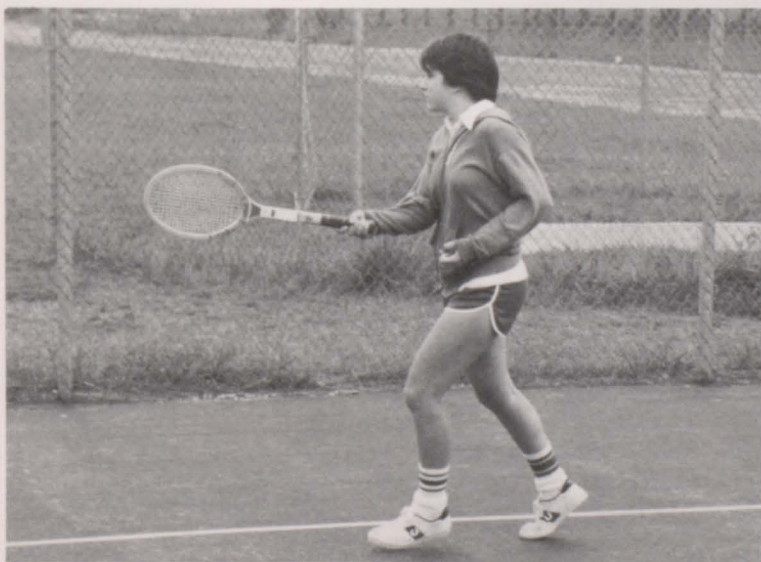
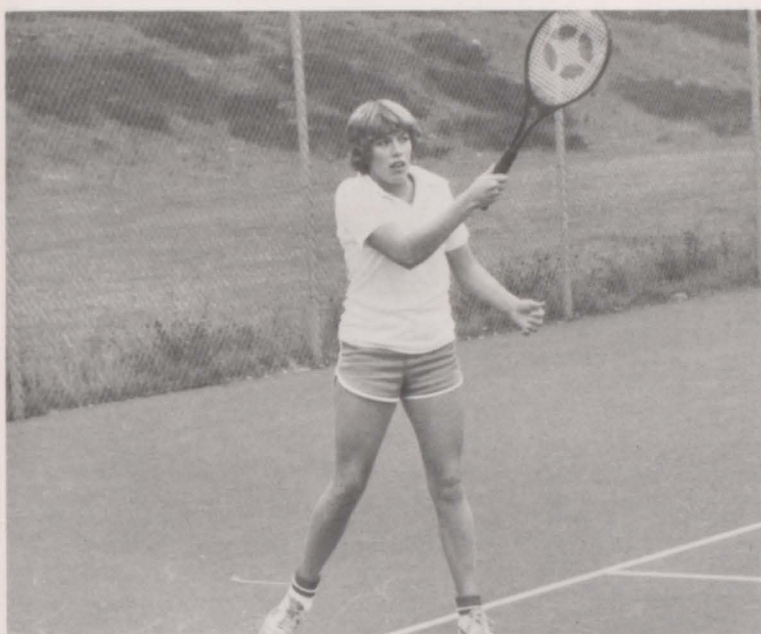
The Girls Tennis Team, with 11 wins and 3 losses, finished second in CLASS B SOUTH, of the Rhode Island Interscholastic League.

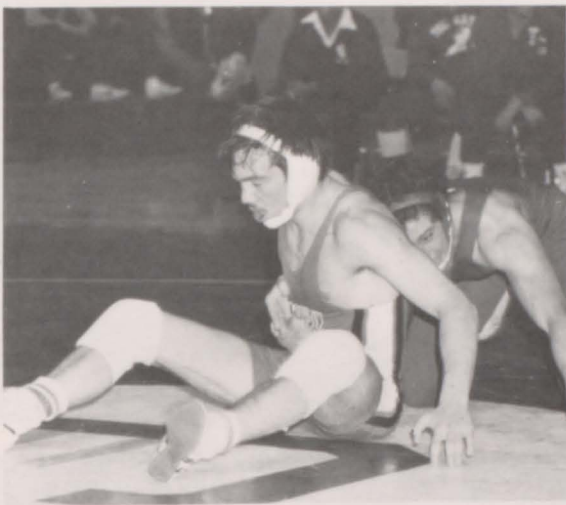

The Oaker wrestling team dominated the R. I. wrestling scene during the 1981-82 season.

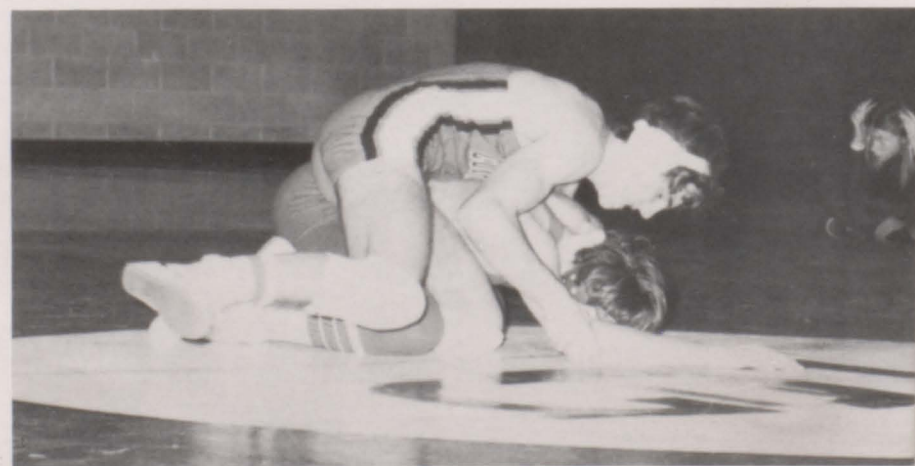
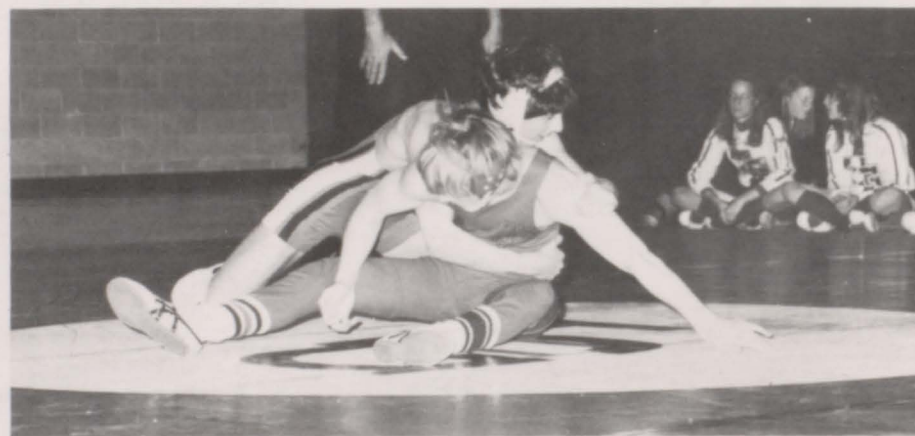
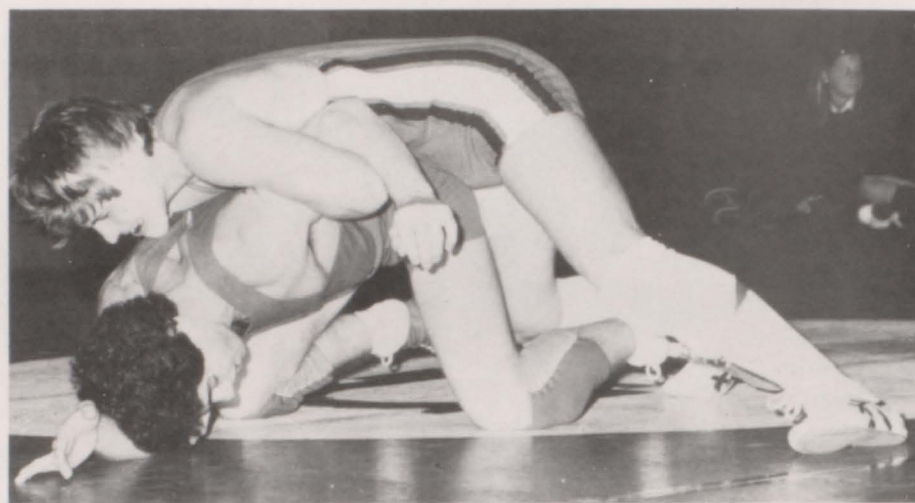

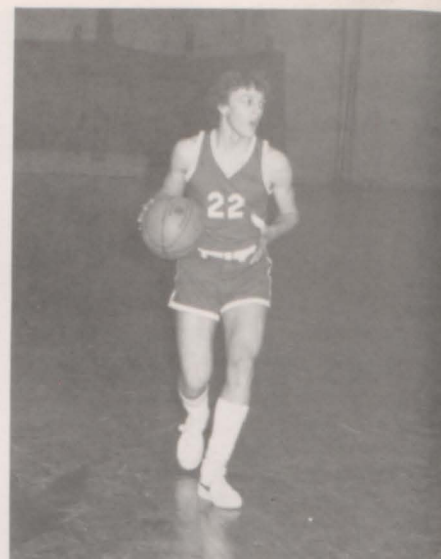
