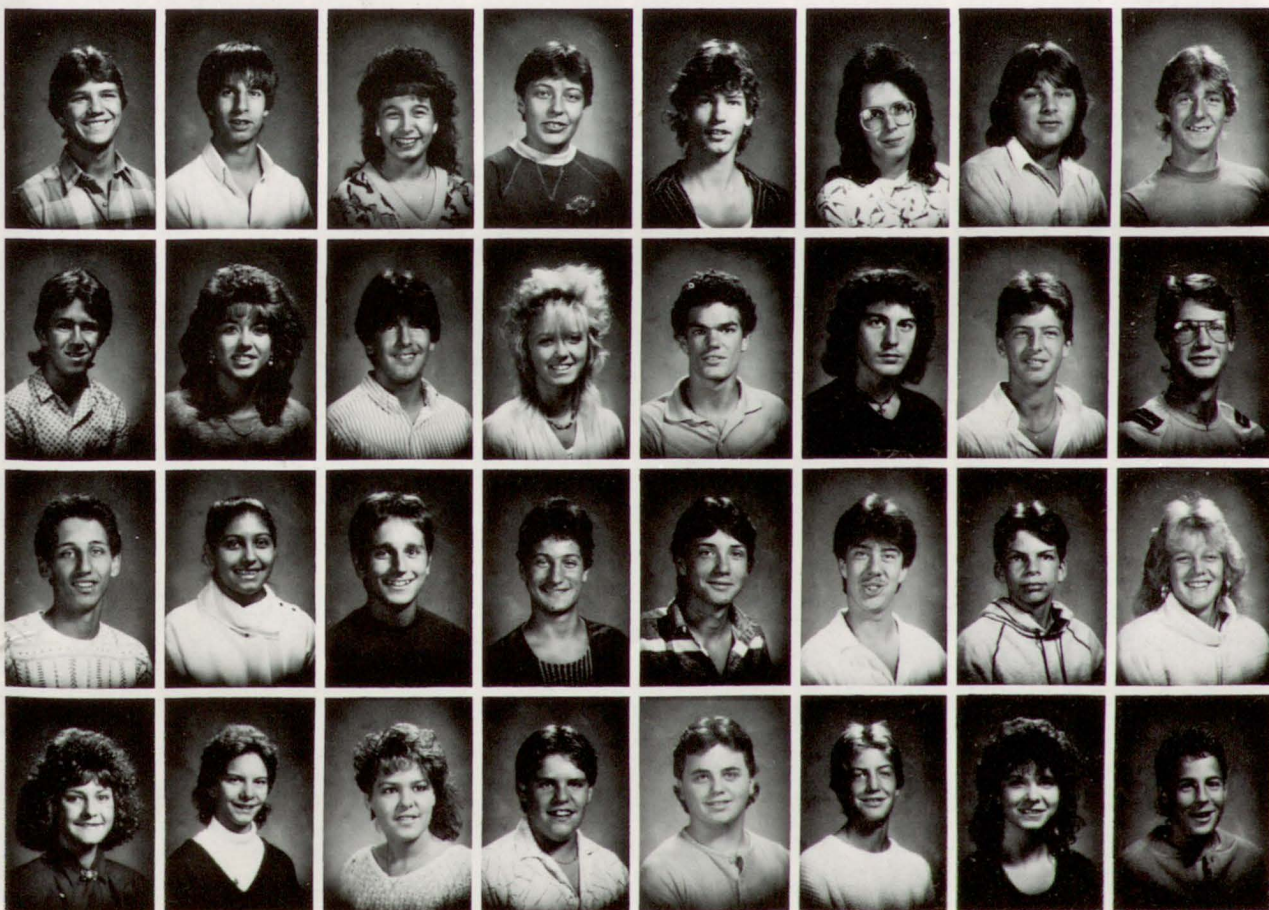


## Check Out The Sophomore Year
