ENVIRONMENTAL RESOURCES

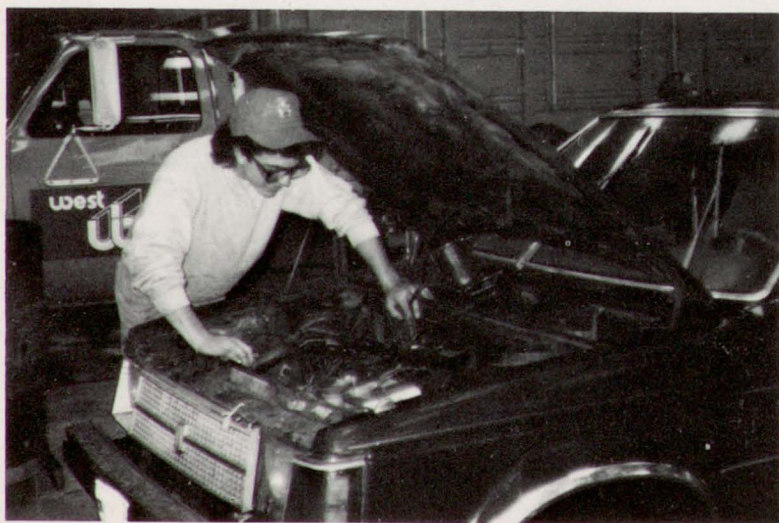
The Environmental Resources Program studies the interrelationship between plants, animals and the environment and the role people play in this relationship. Study units include: classification, ecology, conservation, mammals, reptiles, amphibians, fish, birds, insects, resource management, stream life, pond life, forestry, parks, sanctuaries, refuges, waterfowl, the ocean, environmental issues, landscape design-construction, floriculture, outdoor survival, career opportunities, leadership and more.

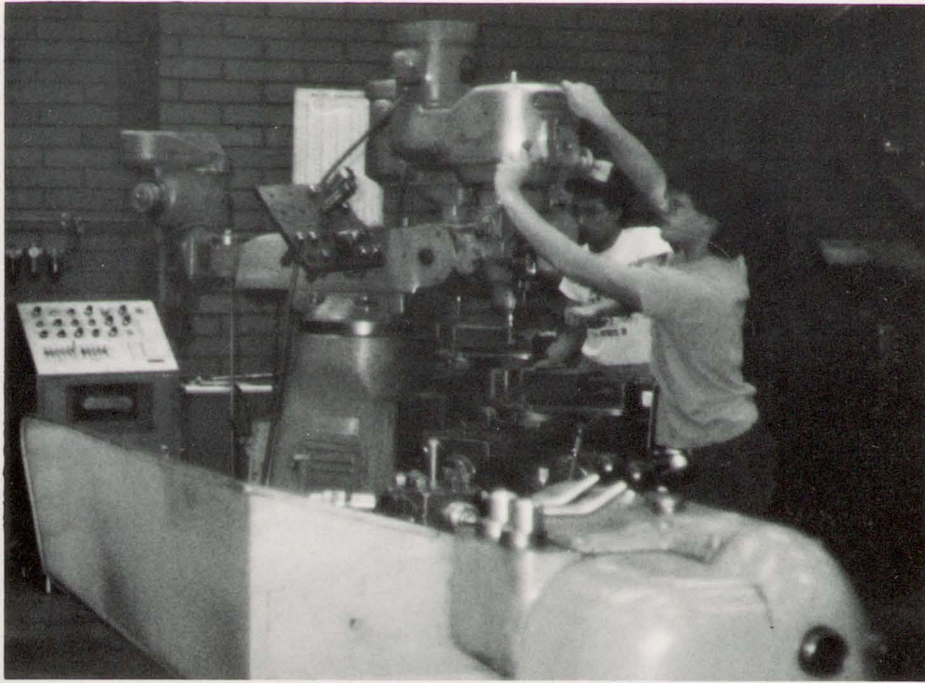
Students learn through lectures, work projects, field studies, visual aides, guest speakers, reading and writing. "Learning by Doing" is stressed throughout the entire program. For example, students completed their study of whales by going to Cape Cod Bay and seeing nature's largest mammal in it's natural habitat. A typical school day could find us indoors learning land-

scape theory, building wood duck nestboxes, discussing our National Park System, classifying mushrooms, or viewing a video about Grizzly Bears or outdoors identifying animal tracks in the snow, collecting plant samples, tree-climbing to censor screech owl nestboxes, canoeing the Wood River or visiting a waterfowl sanctuary.

Students bring to class a varied background of knowledge and experience. Some are avid hunters and fishermen. Others enjoy the aesthetics of our plant and wildlife communities. Some are simply curious about the outdoors and want to learn more. Others are career oriented and plan to further their education or work in an Environmental Resource setting. All students are encouraged to share their knowledge and experience in a unique learning environment that offers unlimited opportunity to learn about the world in which they life.







MACHINE PROCESSES

The Machine Processes program provides students with the fundamentals of machine-tool operation. The students gain knowledge of the construction of machine tools and the principles underlying their operations in today's scientific and computerized world. While emphasis is placed on machine tool operation, much attention is given to design, cost, and production of tools, dies and machine parts.

Through hands-on training, students learn and develop many new skills. Some of the students are actually surprised at the amount of knowledge they have required.

Machinists work from blueprints to determine which machines are to be used in production. They choose from a variety of milling machines, lathes, planers, grinders, drill presses, boring machines, and others. They select the stock to be used, lay out their work, set up the machine, adjust for precise operation (sometimes within a millionth of an inch), operate and repair them.





PRINTING AND GRAPHICS

The Printing and Graphics program exposes students to many different phases in the production of a finished printed item.

These include: design and layout, process camera operation, platemaking, offset printing and finished operations. Each phase is learned by doing them repeatedly. By repetition, complicated processes become fun.

Students are encouraged to develop their own projects. Students have designed anything from Aerosmith pads to restaurant menus. One of our students designed the Kindergarten Evaluation forms used in the Coventry school system.

Students are encouraged to develop skills at their own rate. With extensive hands on training, everyone

learns each aspect of the printing and graphics program. Some students are amazed with what they have learned by the end of the program. Many students do not realize that while having fun with their projects, they were actually learning a lot more than they thought. In the Senior year, some students begin to specialize. They become press operators, darkroom technicians, typesetters, and more. In their Senior year, students can Co-op out! This means they attend classes until 11:00 A.M. and are released to work at Co-op companies. In summary, the Printing and Graphics Program develops technical skills, is highly individualized, provides excellent opportunity for employment, and is fun.
