Dear Graduates :

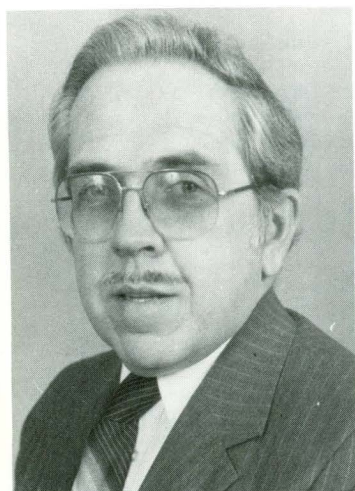
It is with great pleasure that I, as principal, congratulate each of you as you prepare to graduate from your Alma Mater.

West Bay now offers a new course of study in child care. It is a two year program which prepares students for a career in various job opportunities involving young children.

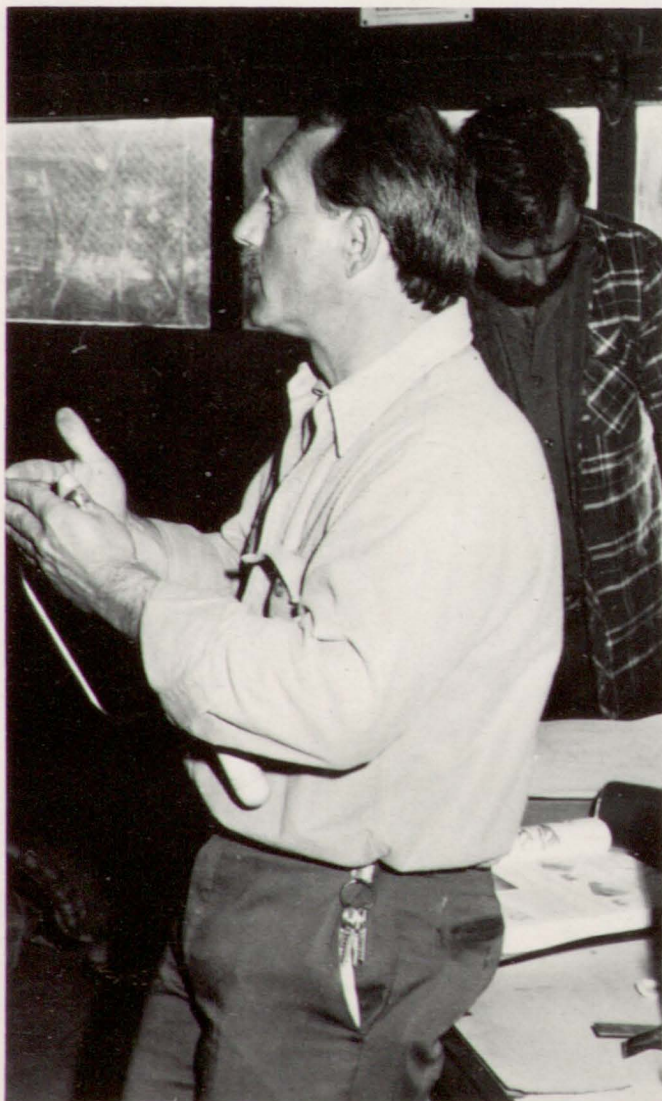
