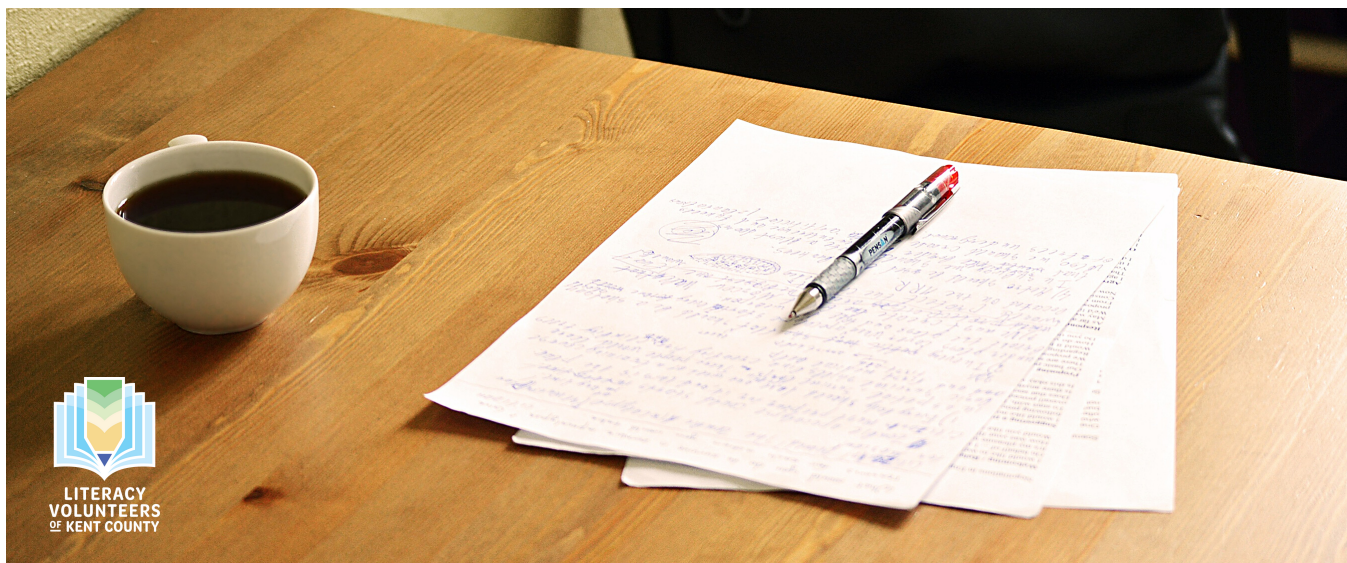

An article by Thoughtful Learner called "Eyes on Editing" was brought to our attention. The article commented on noticing editing mistakes from a class assignment, and how to instill better editing habits by:

- Reiterating the *purpose* of editing
- Reiterating the *importance* of editing
- Recommending when to edit
- Introducing editing strategies
- Modeling and practicing editing strategies

This month we added new resources to our Learning Resources webpage, read on to learn more about the additions, and visit the webpage to check them out!

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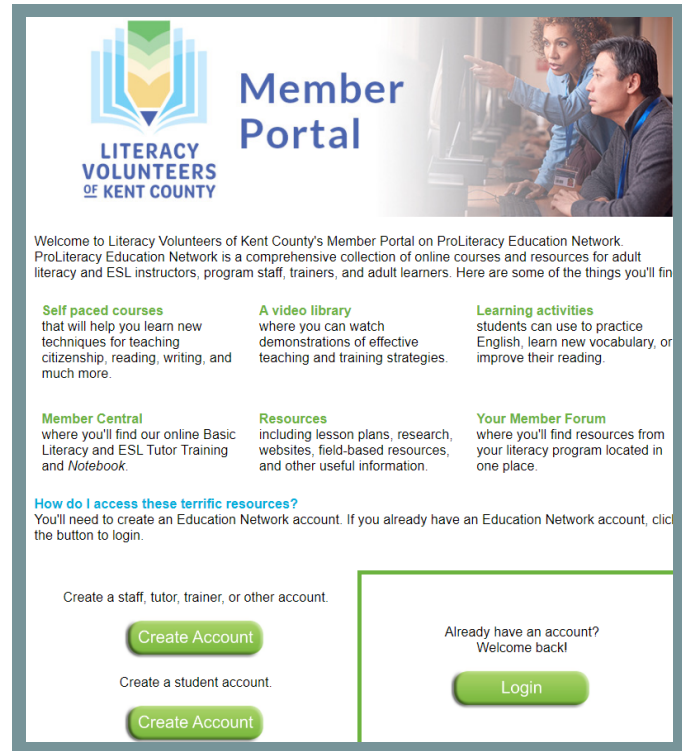
ProLiteracy Education Network

For tutors, you may find online courses, lesson plans, podcasts, articles, and other resources to help infuse your lessons with new ideas and approaches that keep students engaged.

For students, as you work to improve your reading, writing, English, or math, there will be helpful tools on the network. This includes documents to help improve writing or test taking skills, websites to help you learn English, and Reading activities to do with children.
