





































Freshman Class History

The Coventry Lady Oakers Basketball Season at a glance:




Senior Captain Mary Barden and Senior play er Amanda Wahl set the foundation to complete in very strong and competitive Division I South.

Overall, the teams competed with strength. The coaches put a team on the court each night the demonstrated a competitive basketball team. The teams' futures look very bright for 2006-2007.














Yearbook Club





Model Legislature




After their trip to the State House, all bills submitted were passed into Model Legislature law.

Health Careers


Manufacturing

AFJROTC FALCON DRILL TEAM COLOR GUARD


