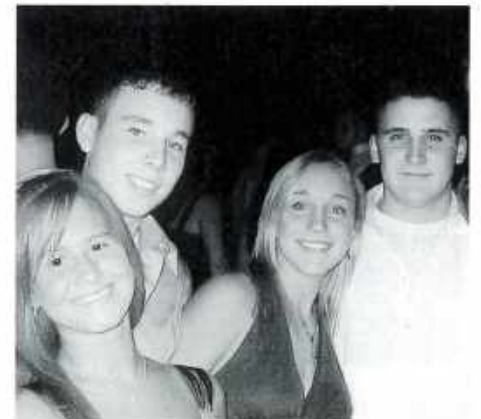
After months of planning and hard work from the Coventry Student Council, the dance was a great success.

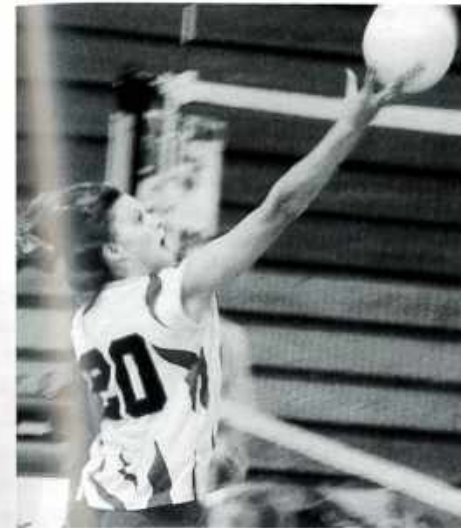

The Junior and Varsity teams practiced and traveled together building a 'family-like' bond throughout the basketball season.

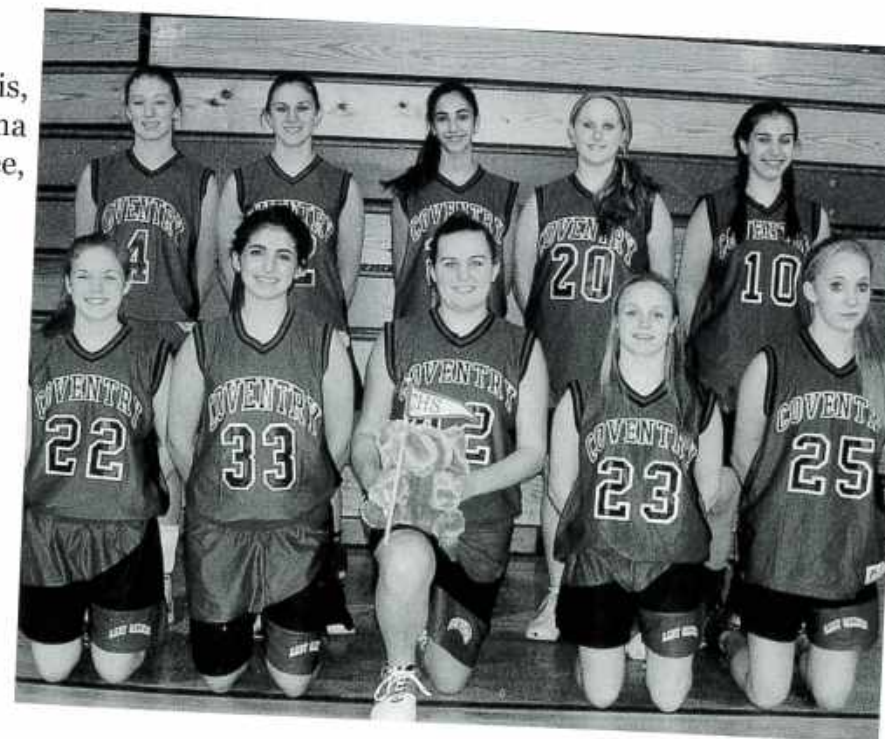

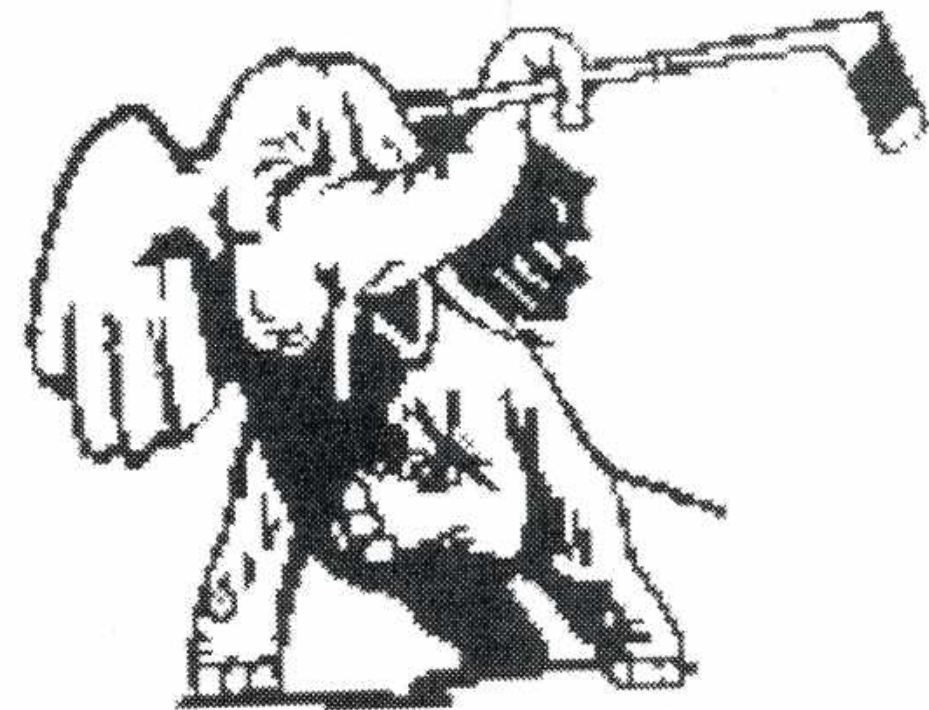
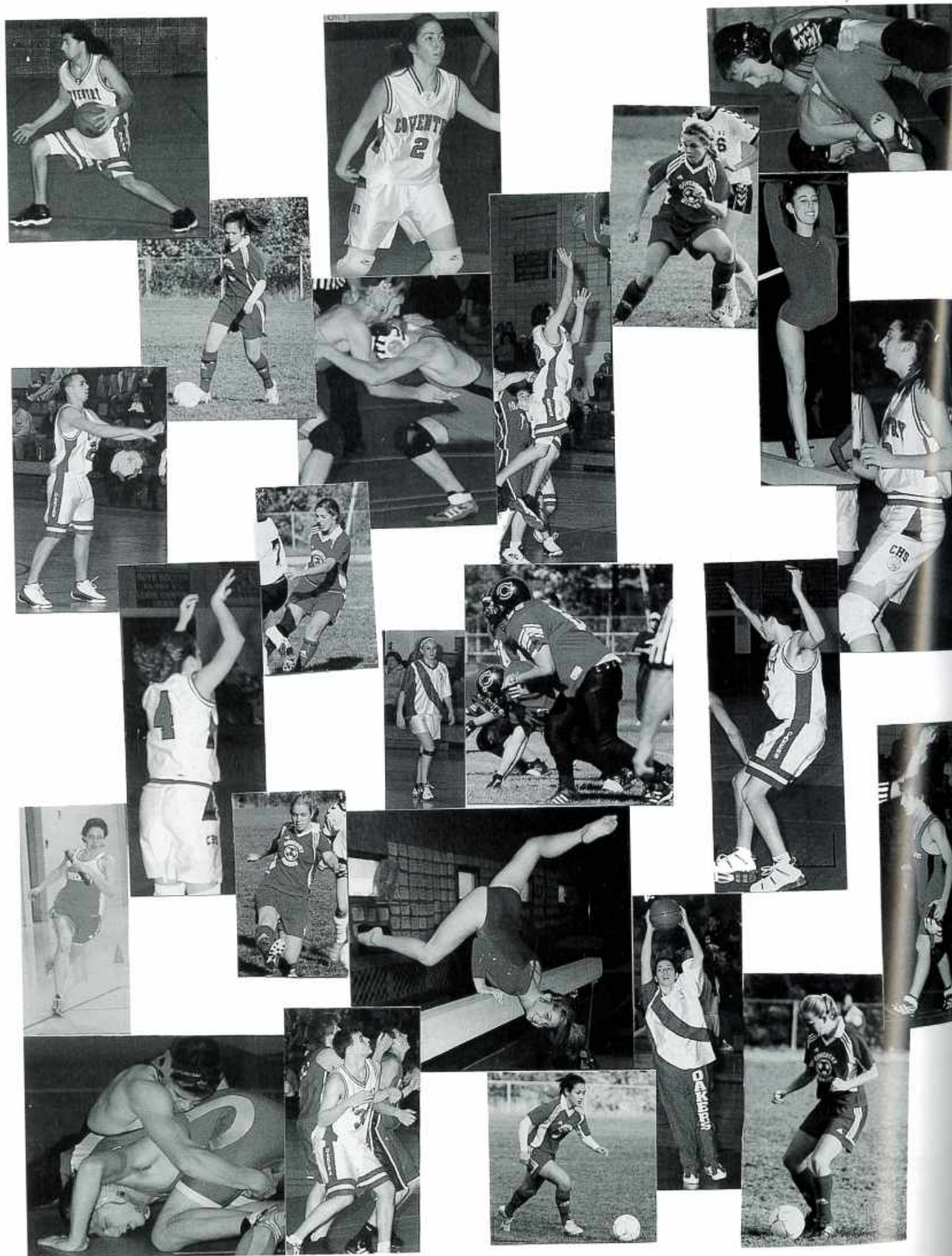

AIR FORCE JUNIOR ROTC

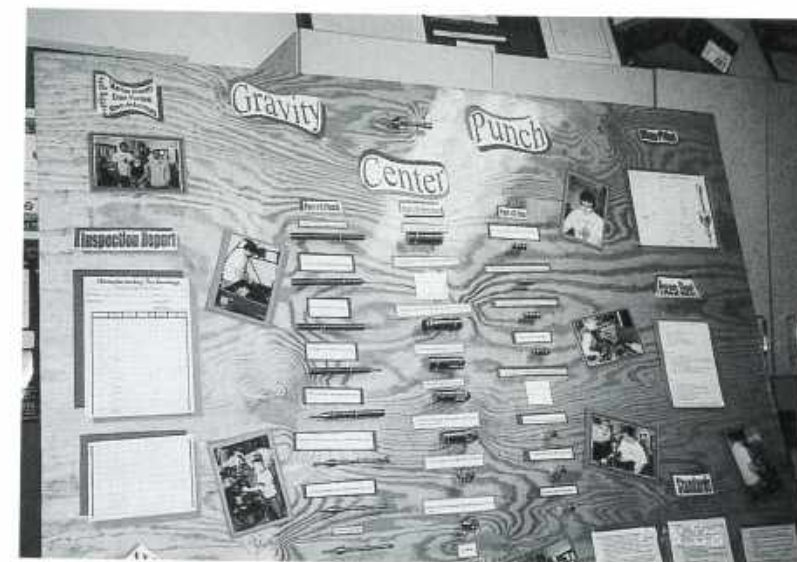
