Now that we're Seniors, high school is sweet dreamin' from here on out. Yeah Oh-Eight'ers!

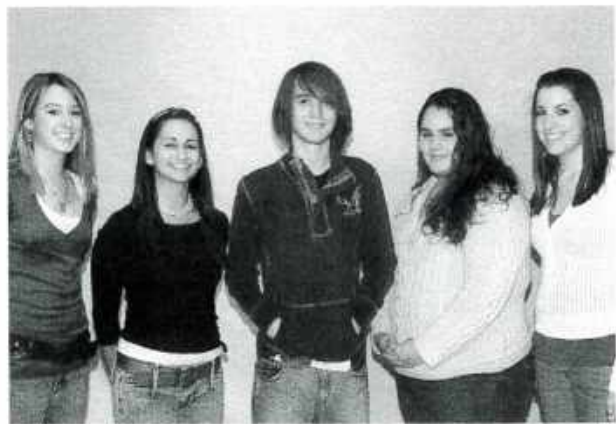

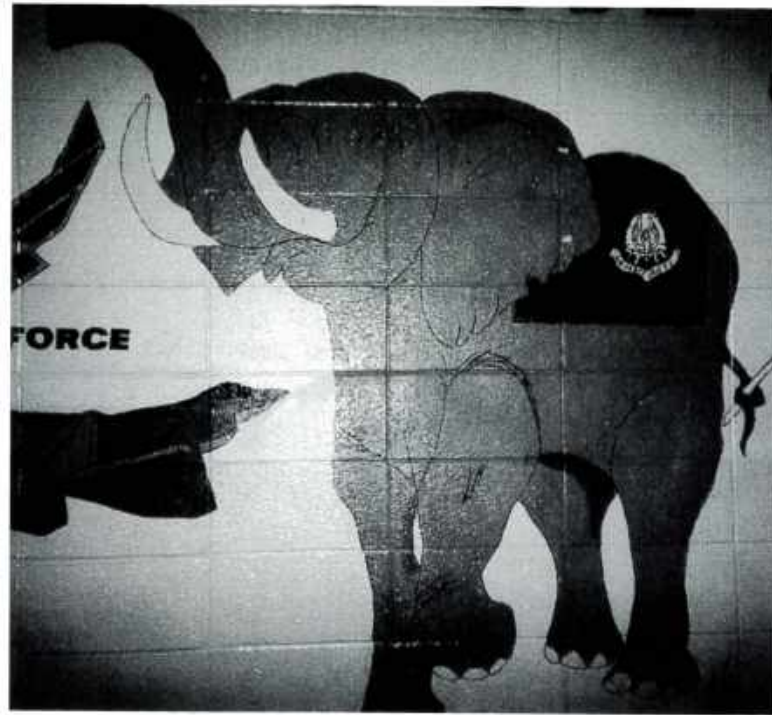
Career and Technical Center

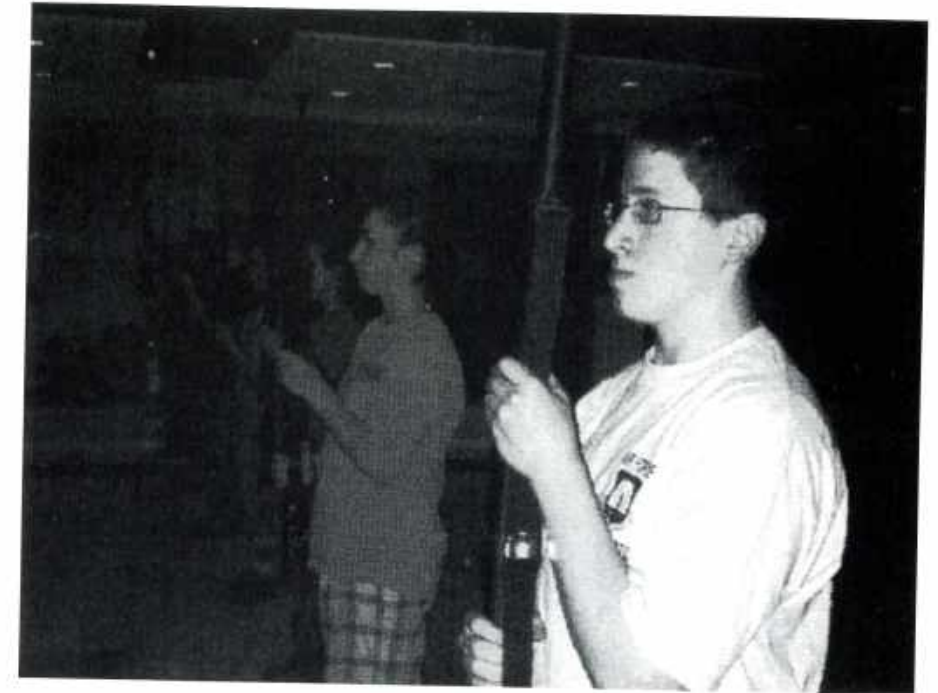

High School Juniors and Seniors are eligible for induction into the National Honor Society. Selection and continued membership are based on the four pillars of NHS. These pillars consist of scholarship, service, leadership, and character all weighted equally. Students do not apply for membership. Selection and induction are honors bestowed on the student.

The scholarship standard is based on a student's cumulative grade point average (GPA) beginning in ninth grade until the first semester of their current grade. The scholarship standard is a GPA of 3.65.

The service by one's Senior year. Service hours may accumulate beginning in ninth grade.

Rhode Island Honor Society Standards

High School Seniors are eligible for induction in the Rhode Island Honor Society with a GPA of 3.35 by the end of first semester.

The National Honor Society expanded into the community with hands on leadership and partnered with Habitat for Humanity and Helping Children in Uganda.

C.L.A.S.S

The Coventry School Department has established an alternative program designed for students who need to make up two years worth of credits in one year. Thus, the students in this program are forced to work extremely hard and put forth all of their effort to succeed and graduate with their class. Students can decide to attend the school for a year and then return to high school. The program, though challenging, proves to be very rewarding for the students, for although they are taking numerous courses simultaneously, they also are given a second chance to graduate with their fellow classmates.

Science Club



The Science Club is now under the direction of Mr. Rockwell this year. The Science Club meets on Wednesdays, for the joint purpose of having fun and learning more about what else, science! This group has done many demonstrations and hands-on activities that have made this club so great. The club continues to strive with the support of the science department chair, Mrs. Sullivan and the rest of the CHS staff.

The Science Club is a club in which students are able to take part in the community, and have fun. Each week, students are welcome to participate in a meeting. Friendships are made and knowledge about the scientific world around us is divided. Here at Coventry High School, students are able to join clubs that they have a genuine interest in. Student Council

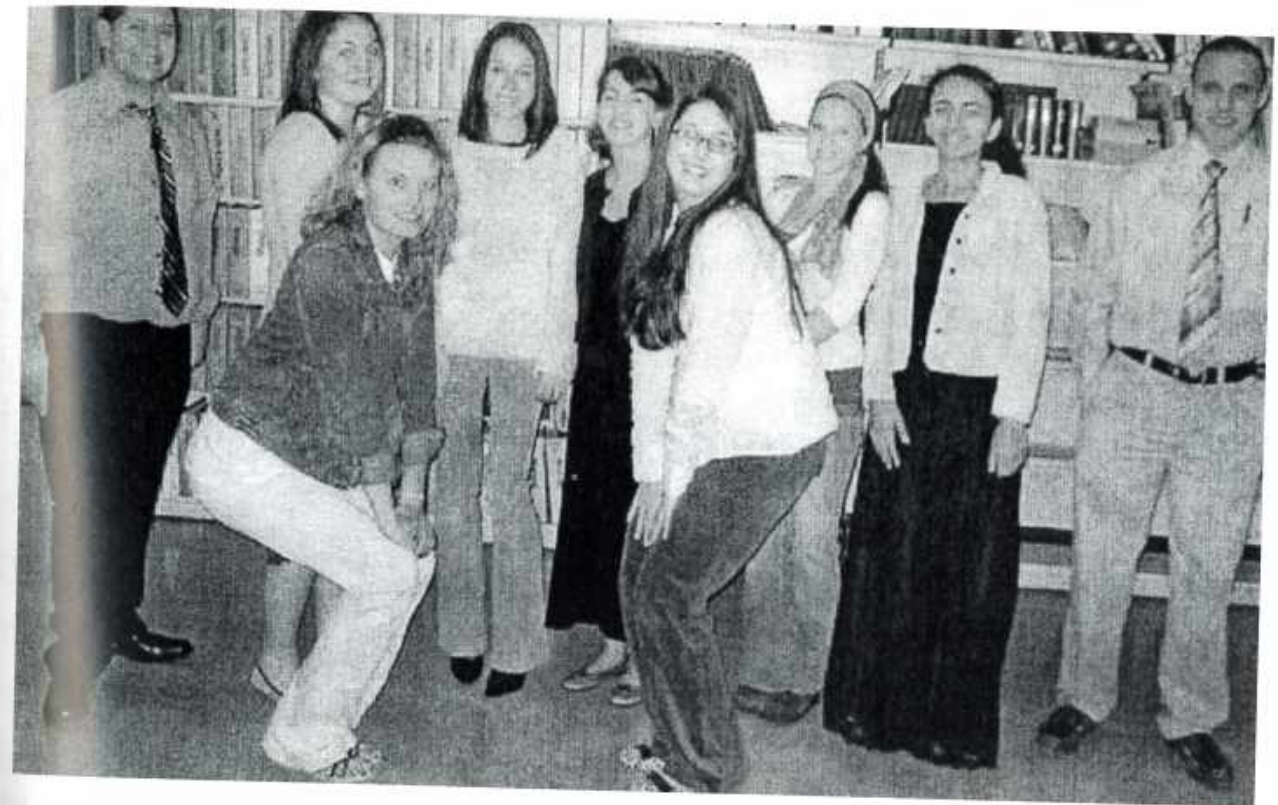
