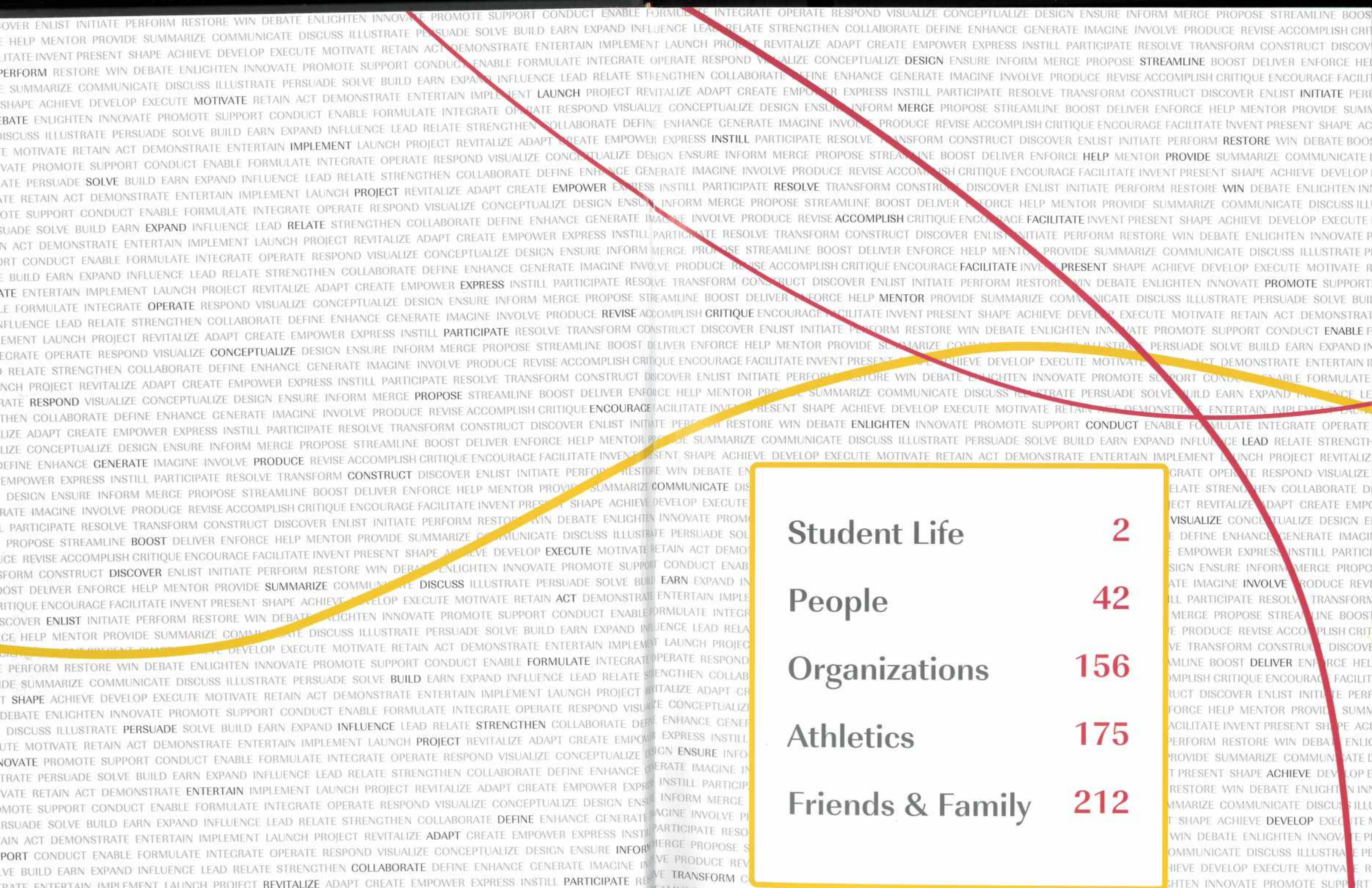

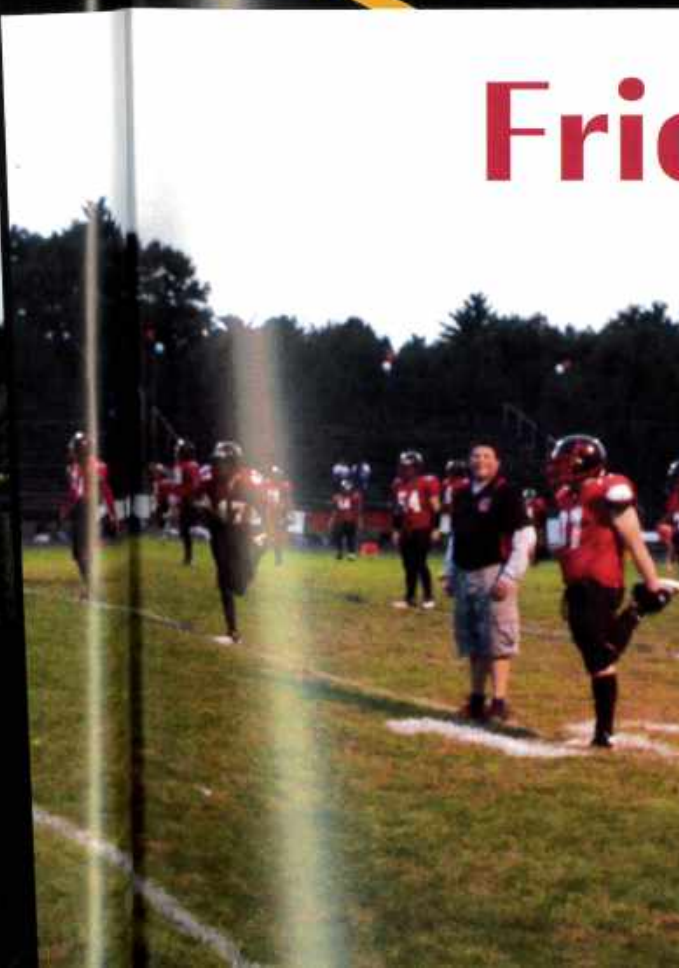

Friday Night Lights



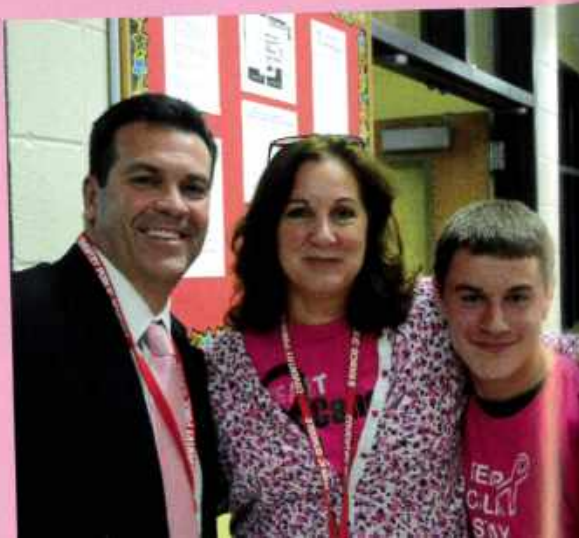

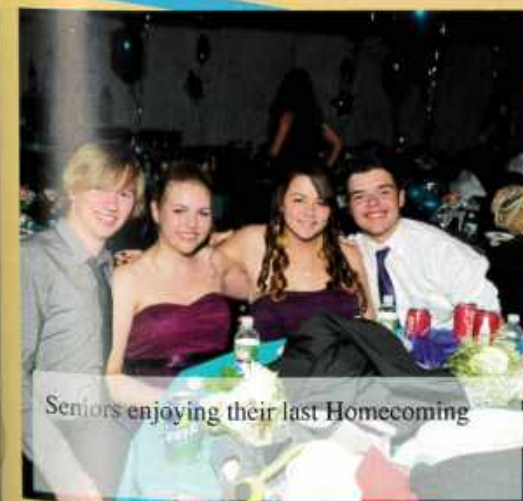
HOMECOMING GAME

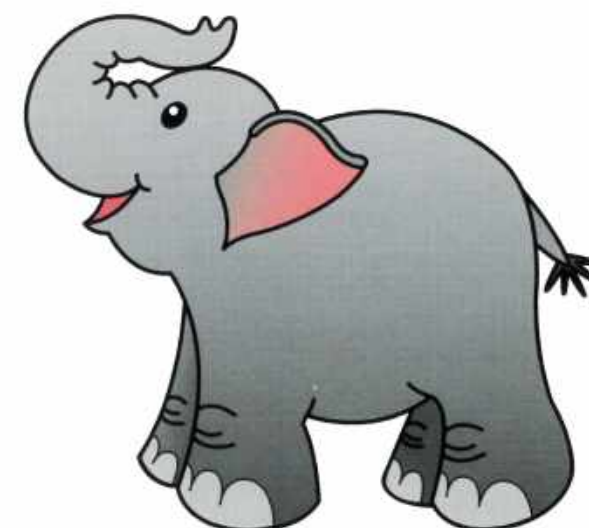


Pep Rally

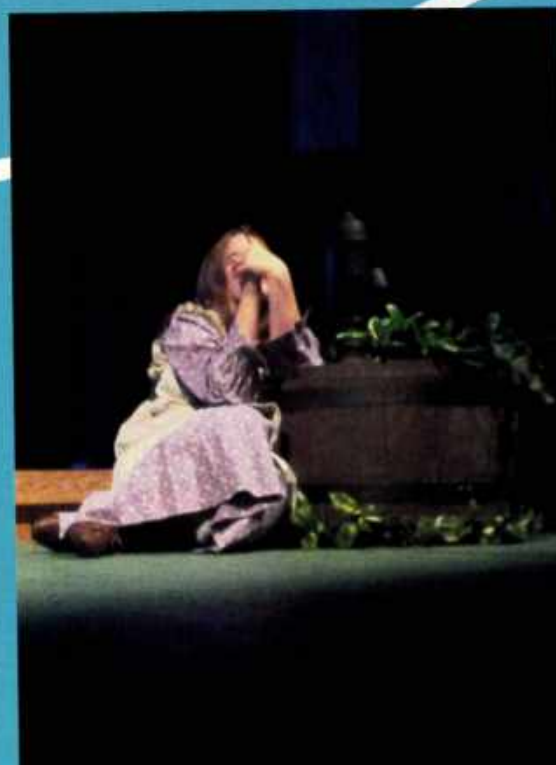

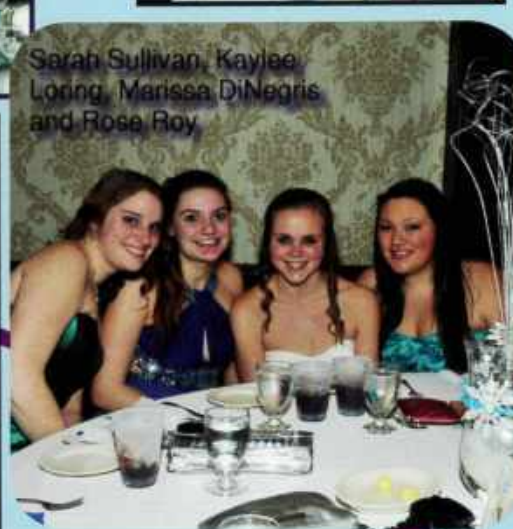

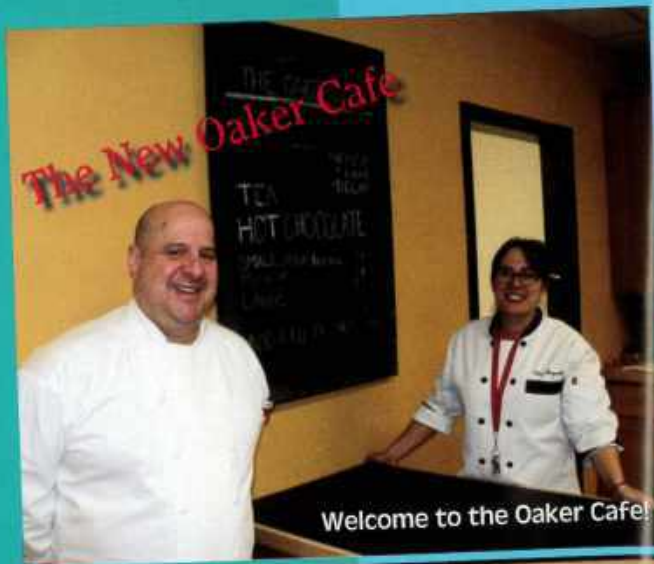

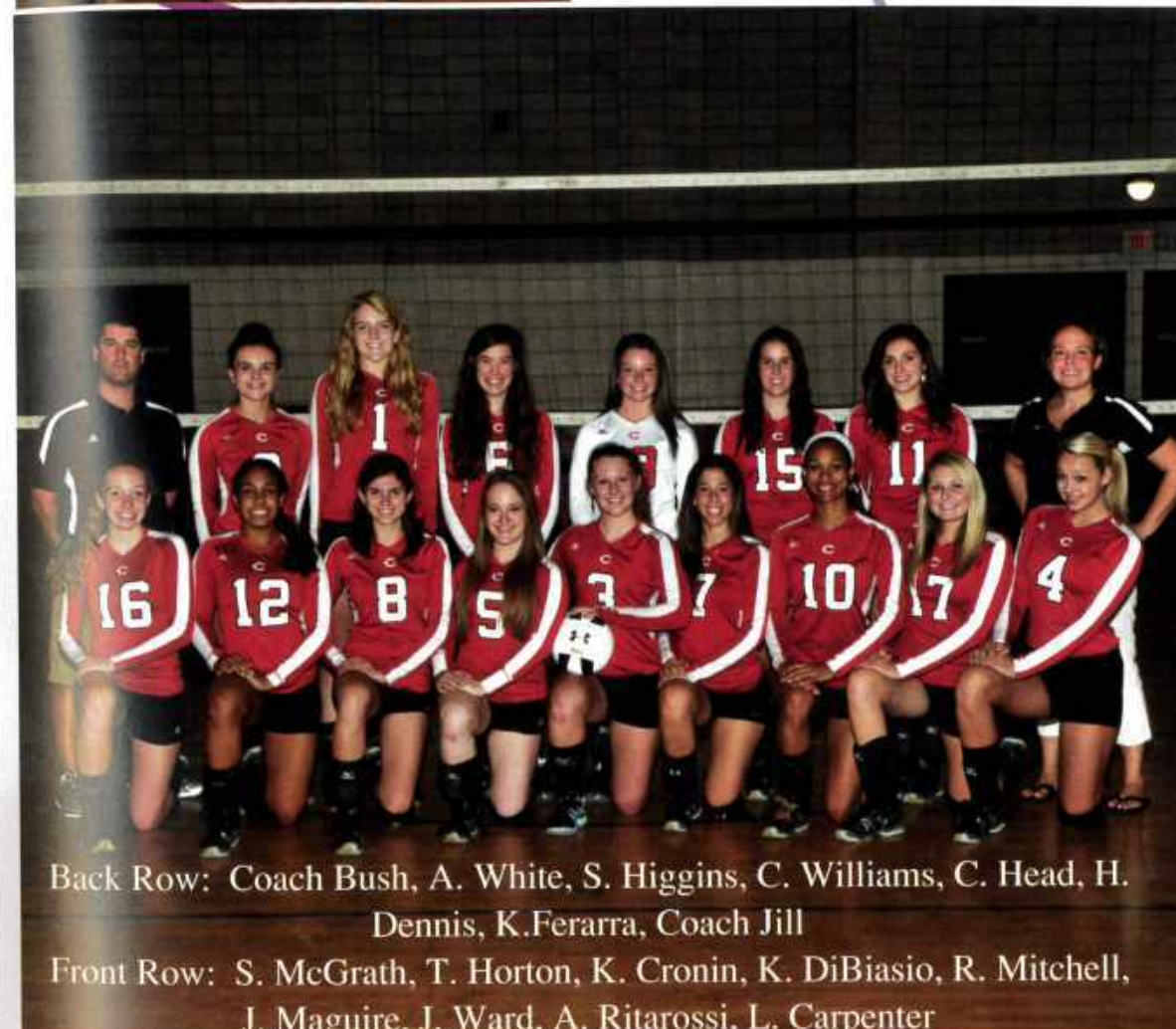

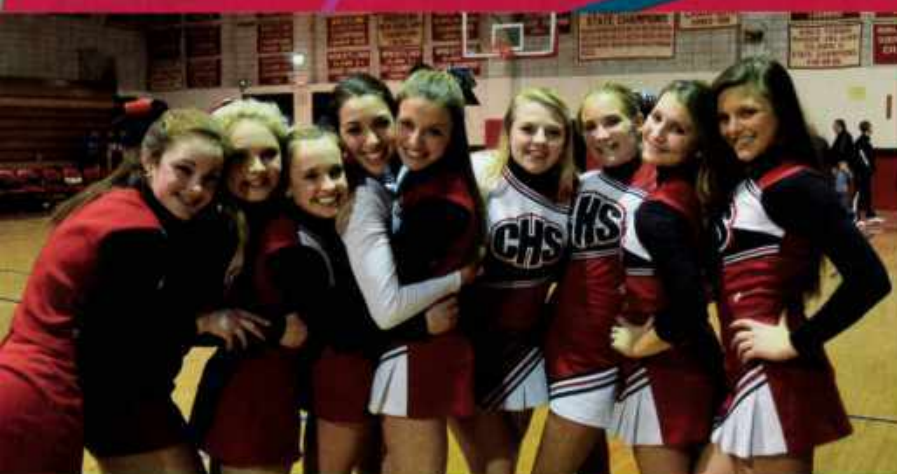

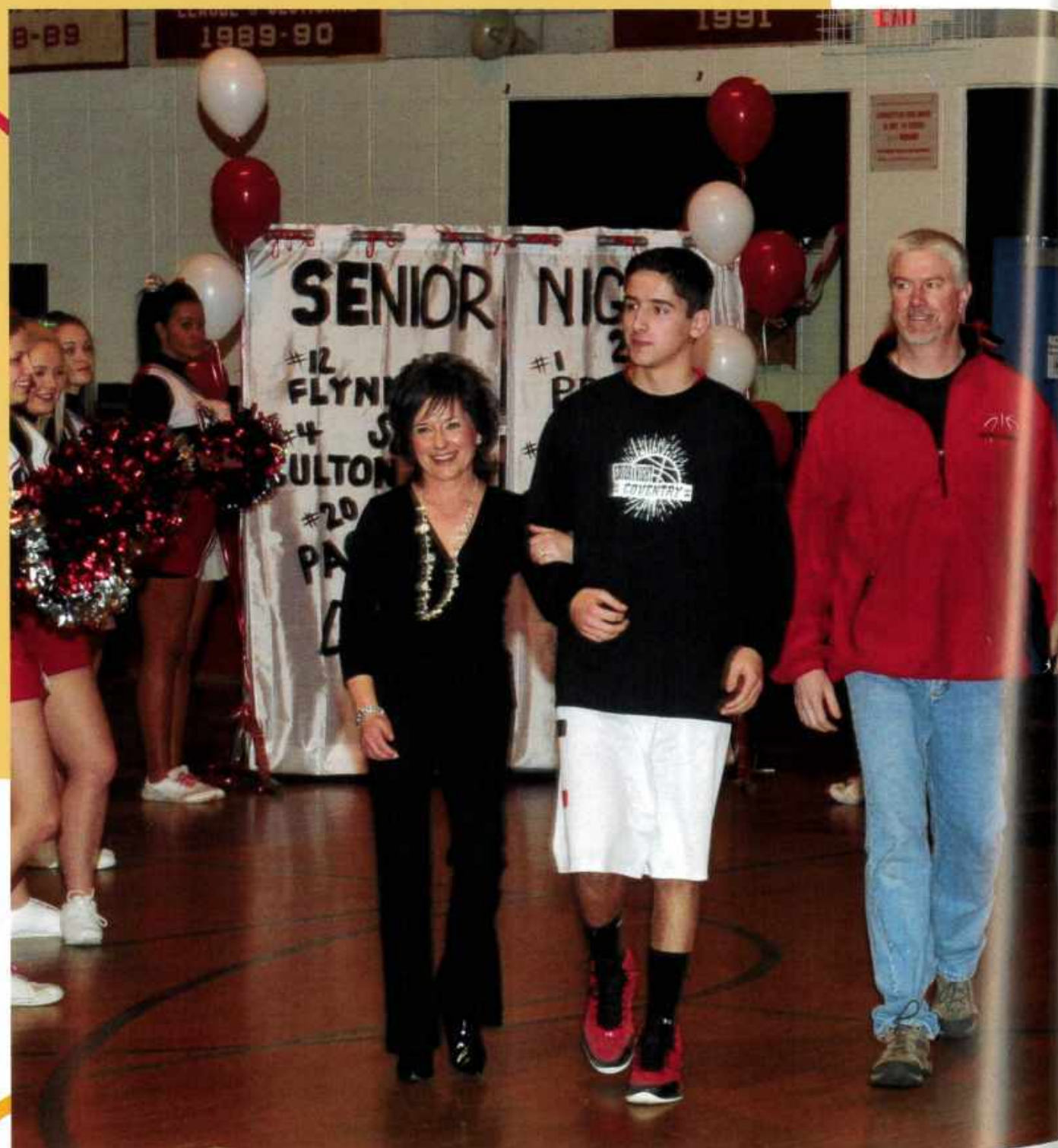


Lip Sync

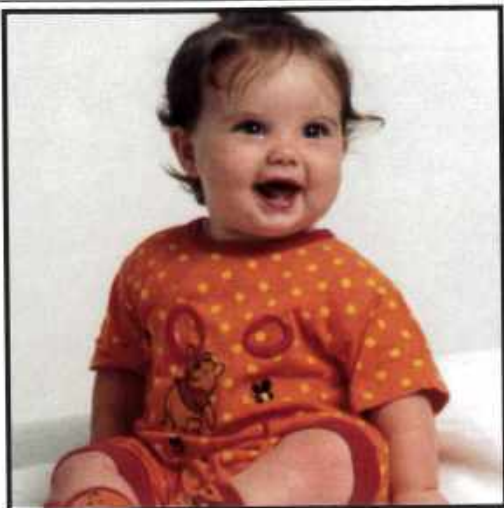

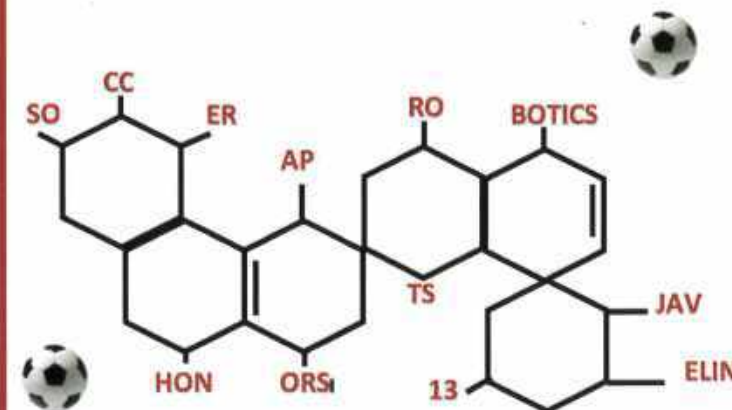

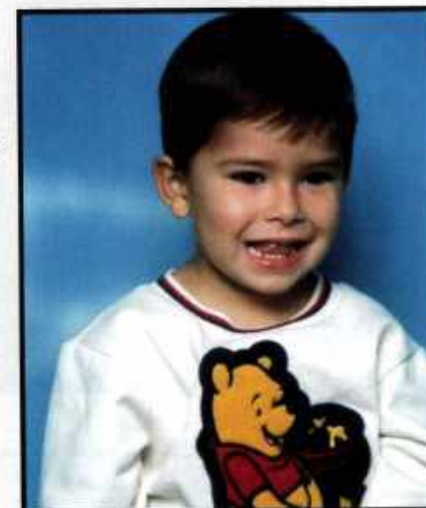
