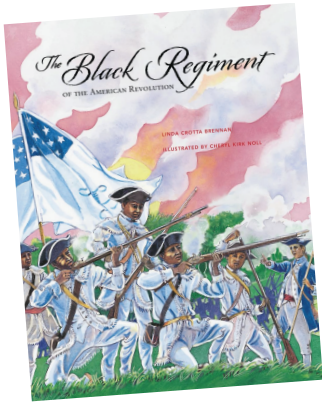

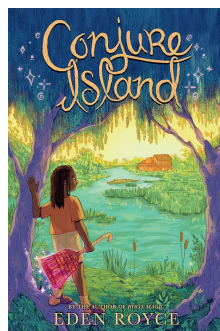
Greene Farmer's Market

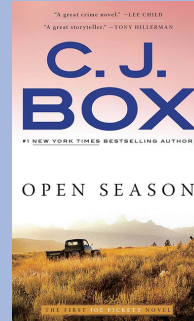

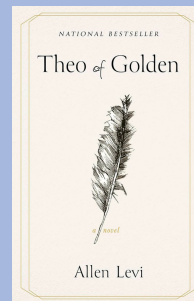
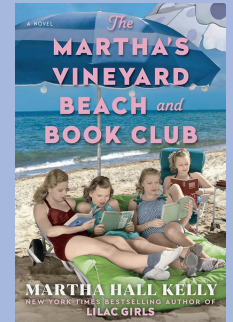
